Honorable John A. Manglona

Associate Justice, Commonwealth Supreme Court



Justice John A. Manglona has been a justice of the Commonwealth Supreme Court since May 2000. He served as an Associate Judge in the Superior Court from 1998 to 2000 and Designated Justice of the Guam Supreme Court from 1999-2003. He continues to assist the Guam Supreme Court as a Justice Pro Tem.

Justice Manglona received a B.A. in Political Economy from the University of California at Berkeley in 1981. He graduated from Creighton University School of Law (J.D., 1984) and the University of the Pacific, McGeorge School of Law (LL.M. in Taxation, 1988). Prior to his appointment to the bench, Justice Manglona was in private practice focusing on probate, corporations, tax, and real property transactions.

Justice Manglona actively participates in the Judiciary's outreach programs such as the Law and the Freshman Legislator, High School Mock Trial, We the People competition, National Forensics League,

Justices in the Classroom, and Law Week.

Justice Manglona is married to U.S. District Court Chief Judge Mona V. Manglona, and they are blessed with two children.
