In view of the new reporting requirements in the PROTECT Act of 2003, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. After sentencing in each case, the Courtroom Deputy of the United States
District Court of the Northern Mariana Islands shall assemble a "Report of Sentence"
that includes the following documents:

- a cover page setting forth the sentence, the offense or offenses for which it was imposed, the age, race, and sex of the offender, and all adjustments and departures actually applied in fashioning the sentence;
- (b) a copy of the judgment and commitment order;
- (c) a copy of the Court's statement of reasons for the sentence imposed;
- (d) a copy of any plea agreement;

- (e) a copy of each and all charging document filed in the case, including complaints, indictments, superseding indictments, informations, and superseding informations; and
- (f) a copy of the presentence report.
- 2. Within twenty days after sentencing in each case, the Courtroom Deputy shall present to the Clerk of Court of the Northern Mariana Islands or his authorized Deputy Clerk, two copies of the cover page along with the remainder of the Report of Sentence.
- 3. The Clerk of Court or his authorized Deputy Clerk shall mail the Report of Sentence to the Sentencing Commission.
- 4. In the event a Report of Sentence is not presented within twenty days after sentencing, the Clerk of Court or his authorized Deputy Clerk shall report the deficiency to the attention of the Chief Judge.
