Rule 6(c) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure states that the foreperson of the grand jury "will sign all indictments." The Judicial Conference of the United States has determined that in light of privacy concerns, documents containing identifying information about jurors or potential jurors should not be included in the public case file.
