JURY WHEEL FOR GRAND AND PETIT JURORS.

GENERAL ORDER # 19-0001

Pursuant to the Jury Selection and Service Act and the Plan for Random Jury Selection of the United States District Court for the Northern Mariana Islands,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that on Monday, March 4, 2019 at 10:00 AM, the Clerk of Court, or her authorized deputies and System Manager, shall empty the existing 2015 Voter Registration List, and that under his supervision, refill the database with the names listed in the Voter Registration List (VRL) of the 2018 General Election of the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, furnished by the Board of Elections Commission consisting of 18,926 names.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ensuring the emptying and refilling of the database, the Clerk of Court, or her authorized deputies and System Manager, shall randomly draw 25% or 4,731 names from the 2018 Voter Registration List (database) which shall constitute this Court's Master Jury Wheel.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that subsequent to the establishment of the Court's Master Jury  
2 Wheel, the Clerk of Court or her authorized deputies and System Administrator, shall randomly draw  
3 50% or 2,365 names from the Master Jury Wheel and shall cause such persons to be investigated for  
4 eligibility. After such persons are found to be eligible, such names shall be placed in the Qualified  
5 Jury Wheel for this Court's future use in empaneling its Grand and Petit Jury Pools.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an alphabetical listing of names drawn for the Master Jury  
7 Wheel and an alphabetical listing of names drawn for qualification shall be prepared. The necessary  
8 questionnaires needed to ascertain the qualification of prospective jurors drawn shall also be printed  
9 and mailed by the Clerk of Court, or her authorized deputies, at the earliest date.

10 Copies of this Order shall be delivered to the United States Attorney and posted on the Court's  
11 website.
