IT IS ORDERED that not later than twenty-four (24) hours after the sentencing of a defendant who has been convicted after a trial the court reporter who reported the case shall deliver to the clerk of the court for filing in the case a reasonably accurate itemized estimate of the cost of the transcript (and copies) for an appeal. The reporter should also mail copies thereof to the United States Attorney and defendant's attorney (or the defendant if not represented by counsel).

The itemization shall include:

- 1. Any reported pretrial hearing.
- 2. Voir dire examination of jurors.
- 3. Opening statements.
- 4. The trial.
- 5. The judge's instructions to the jury.
- 6. Arguments of counsel.
- 7. Sentencing proceedings.

A sample form of an estimate for this purpose is attached to this order.
