GENERAL ORDER NO. 7

IT IS ORDERED that all petitions in bankruptcy must show the social security number or tax identification number of the debtor. This order applies to both voluntary and involuntary petitions, and also to all proceedings under the relief chapters of the Bankruptcy Act. The numbers will then be shown on all notices of first meetings of creditors.

This order is entered at the request of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts and the Internal Revenue Service. The inclusion of the social security number or tax identification number on the notice of first meeting of creditors will materially assist the Internal Revenue Service in the prompt and accurate filing of claims in bankruptcy proceedings.
