

Rule 3(a) Appeal from Final Judgement

An appeal to the Appellate Division of the District Court may be taken from a final judgement of the Commonwealth Trial Court. An appeal to the Appellate Division of the District Court may likewise be taken from a final judgement of the Trial Division of the District Court exercising jurisdiction over a matter pursuant to 48 U.S.C. §1694a(b).

Appeals from the Trial Division of the District Court shall also be governed by these rules wherever applicable.
