ABOUT THE CONTEST

- The photo should reflect the prompt "Cornerstones of Democracy: Civics, Civility, and Collaboration."
- Students must include a brief description on how their photo represents the theme with no more than 150 words. Photos inside the courthouse facility are not allowed.
- Each submission must be a student's own original photo.
- Photos will be judged according to their originality, creativity, and how well they represent the theme.
- Winners will be announced at the end of May. Cash prizes and certificates will be presented to winners.
