GENERAL INFORMATION REGARDING ADMISSION TO PRACTICE

(Effective November 1, 2017)

In addition to the pro hac vice admission rule (Local Rule 83.5.d), the United States District Court for the Northern Mariana Islands allows two forms of admission: Temporary and Permanent.

1. **TEMPORARY ADMISSION - Local Rule 83.5.c or its successor**

- a. Limited to attorneys employed by the United States government or one of its agencies, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands or one of its agencies, the CNMI Public Defender, Micronesian Legal Services Corporation, and Northern Marianas Protection and Advocacy Systems.
- b. Applicant must provide personal identification and proof that he or she is a member in good standing of the bar of the highest court of any state, territory, or the District of Columbia.
- c. Applicant must complete a verified petition for admission.
- d. Applicant is required to pay an admission fee of \$299.00 in cash or check payable to "Clerk, District Court of the Northern Mariana Islands".
- e. Admission is automatically terminated when applicant is no longer employed by one of the bodies identified in 1(a) above and has not yet taken and passed the Commonwealth Bar Examination. Re-admission is required for attorneys seeking permanent admission after a change in employment status.

2. **PERMANENT ADMISSION - Local Rule 83.5.b or its successor**

- a. Applicant must provide personal identification and proof that he or she is a member in good standing of the Commonwealth Bar.
- b. Applicant must complete a verified petition for admission.
- c. Applicant must appear before the Clerk of Court or a designated Deputy Clerk to take the oath or affirmation. Admission by mail is NOT permitted.
- d. Applicant is required to pay an admission fee of \$299.00 in cash or check payable to "Clerk, District Court of the Northern Mariana Islands".
- e. Applicant will be contacted when certificate of admission has been prepared.
