Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(e)(2), prior authorization is required for investigative, expert, and other services if the total combined cost for these service providers exceeds \$800.00. Because the CJA representations in this District routinely require use of the services of investigators and interpreters, and the cost of those services combined may ordinarily exceed \$800.00, to avoid the necessity of CJA defense counsel having to expend the time necessary to make applications to exceed the \$800.00 total maximum, the Court hereby authorizes CJA defense counsel to utilize the services of interpreters and investigators up to \$800.00 for each service provider without further order of the Court.

CJA defense counsel and service providers shall otherwise comply with 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(e)(2).
