GENERAL ORDER No. 23-00002

Pursuant to the Jury Selection and Service Act and the Plan for Random Jury Selection of the
United States District Court for the Northern Mariana Islands,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that on Thursday, March 2 at 2:30 p.m., the Clerk of Court, or her
authorized deputies and Systems Manager, shall empty the existing Jury Master Wheel, and that under
her supervision, shall refill the Jury Master Wheel database with the names listed in the Voter
Registration List (VRL) of the November 2022 General Election of the Commonwealth of the
Northern Mariana Islands, furnished by the Commonwealth Election Commission consisting of
19,296 names.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court, or her authorized deputies and Systems
Manager, shall randomly draw 2,200 names from the new Jury Master Wheel database, shall prepare
an alphabetical listing of the names drawn, and shall review these names for qualification to serve as
jurors.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the necessary questionnaires needed to ascertain the
2 qualification of prospective jurors drawn shall be made available through eJuror online and mailed by
3 the Clerk of Court, or her authorized deputies, when requested or if no eJuror response is received
4 within 21 days.

5 Copies of this Order shall be delivered to the United States Attorney and posted on the Court's
6 website.
