The Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure prohibit "the taking of photographs *in the courtroom* during judicial proceedings or the broadcasting of judicial proceedings from the courtroom." Fed. R. Crim. P. 53 (emphasis added). Therefore, there will be no public audio or video streaming of any court proceedings in this case. Cameras, video equipment, photographs, and recordings (audio and video) are prohibited *within the courthouse* unless authorized by a judicial officer. LR 83.2. After the conclusion of all proceedings in the courtroom, the Jury Assembly Room located on the first floor will be made available as a "press room" for logistical support services to all news organizations and to allow for any press conference by either party. In accordance with my authority pursuant to LR 83.2, members of the media may enter the courthouse with cameras and/or audio-and video equipment *for use only at any post-hearing press conference* by the parties in the Jury Assembly Room on the first floor. Photographs and recordings (audio and video) are prohibited areas in the courthouse at any other time. Any violation ///
